

Irrigation Advisory Committee

Purpose Statement:

The Irrigation Advisory Committee is established to provide help in fundraising for the Golf Course Irrigation, and valuable input to the Staff and Board in the final planning for the timing of and design for Irrigation. This group performs in an advisory role and reports to the Board of Commissioners/Executive Director.

Outcomes:

1. Review the findings of VISION 20/20 in relation to the overall Critical Success Factors to better understand the context in which the Golf Course Irrigation fits in SPD's future plans.
2. Review the findings of VISION 20/20 in relation to the Irrigation project.
3. Appoint one individual to serve on the selection committee for the Engineering Firm to do the design work for the irrigation.
4. Complete planning meetings with the Engineering Firm in which discussion of main design ideas are identified and prioritized.
5. Support the Superintendent of Golf in successful completion of the Crowd Sourcing fundraiser.
6. Under the direction of the Fundraising Group, help raise funds for the Irrigation project.
7. Act as a positive liaison for the park district.

Membership:

1. Pre-assigned to this committee are:
 - a. Daryl Graves, Board Commissioner
 - b. Kirk Lundbeck, Golf Operations Superintendent
 - c. Jeff Donahoe, Superintendent of Parks and Facilities
2. Individuals with an overall understanding of, appreciation for, and commitment to golf in Sycamore.
3. No hidden agendas or project specific opinions, but rather a "big picture" perspective toward golf.

4. Understanding that, for now, the focus of the group will be on the golf irrigation, and not any other aspect of golf.
5. A commitment to fundraising under the direction of the Fundraising Group.
6. Time to make all meetings.
7. Ability to modify schedule to attend site visits, if necessary.
8. Ability to prioritize and focus on issues.
9. Three to four additional individuals.
