

Sled Hill Advisory Committee

Purpose Statement:

The Sled Hill Advisory Committee is established to provide help in fundraising for the Sled Hill, and valuable input in the final planning for the design of the Sled Hill. It will make recommendations and prioritize issues as input to the Board and Staff's decision making process. This group performs in an advisory role and reports to the Board of Commissioners/Executive Director.

Outcomes:

1. Review the findings of VISION 20/20 in relation to the overall Critical Success Factors to better understand the context in which the Sled Hill fits in SPD's future plans.
2. Review the findings of VISION 20/20 in relation to the Sled Hill.
3. Travel on and Participate In 2 to 4 Site Visits to Sled Hills.
4. Complete planning meetings with the A/E Firm in which discussion of main design ideas are identified and prioritized.
5. Make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners for priorities in terms of features and construction.
6. Under the direction of the Fundraising Group, help to raise funds for the Sled Hill.
7. Act as a positive liaison for the park district.

Membership:

1. Pre-assigned to this committee are:
 - a. Michelle Schulz, Board Vice President
 - b. Bart Desch, Recreation Superintendent
2. Individuals with an overall understanding of, appreciation for, and commitment to winter fun in Sycamore.
3. No hidden agendas or project specific opinions, but rather a "big picture" perspective toward what the park district is attempting to accomplish.
4. Understanding that, for now, the focus of the group will be on the sled hill as highlighted in the "Purpose Statement".

5. A commitment to fundraising under the direction of the Fundraising Group.
6. Time to make all meetings.
7. Ability to modify schedule to attend site visits, if necessary.
8. Ability to prioritize and focus on issues.
9. Three to five additional individuals.
