

Splashpad Advisory Committee

Purpose Statement:

The Splashpad Advisory Committee is established to provide help in fundraising for the splashpad, and valuable input to the Staff and Board in the final planning for the “program” that will form the core design of the splashpad. This group performs in an advisory role and reports to the Board of Commissioners/Executive Director.

Outcomes:

1. Review the findings of VISION 20/20 in relation to the overall Critical Success Factors to better understand the context in which the Splashpad fits in SPD’s future plans.
2. Review the findings of VISION 20/20 in relation to the Splashpad.
3. Travel on and Participate In 2 to 4 Site Visits to Splashpads.
4. Complete planning meetings with the A/E Firm in which discussion of main design ideas are identified and prioritized.
5. Make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners for priorities in terms of features and construction.
6. Under the direction of the Fundraising Group, help raise funds for the Splashpad.
7. Act as a positive liaison for the park district.
8. Assist the Board with fundraising as guided by the Fundraising Group.

Membership:

1. Pre-assigned to this committee are:
 - a. Ann Tucker, Board Treasurer
 - b. Lisa White, Recreation Supervisor
 - c. Jeff Donahoe or Bob Swedberg from Parks and Facilities staff.
2. Individuals with an overall understanding of, appreciation for, and commitment to aquatics of all types.
3. No hidden agendas or project specific opinions, but rather a “big picture” perspective toward aquatics.

4. Understanding that, for now, the focus of the group will be on the splashpad.
5. A commitment to fundraising under the direction of the Fundraising Group.
6. Time to make all meetings.
7. Ability to modify schedule to attend site visits, if necessary.
8. Ability to prioritize and focus on issues.
9. Three to four additional individuals.
